Fruit Tree Selection in Nebraska APPLES - Apple trees are quite hardy and will do well in most sites across Eastern Nebraska Criteria which are important when selecting varieties are: harvest time and quality, suitability for the uses you desire, proper rootstock selection, disease resistance to **Growing Healthy Citrus and Avocados in the Backyard**

• Subtropical fruit trees need a warm climate • Most citrus fruit freeze at 26F (lemons freeze at 29F) • Citrus trees freeze at 24F • Do not plant in a lawn that requires frequent shallow irrigation – Grass competes for water and nitrogen • Plant on the south side of the house to increase heat units
